Recycling Plastic Bottle Caps

You may place the cap back on your plastic bottle before tossing it in the recycling cart, even though the bottle and the cap are often made of a different plastic resin. Most caps are made of #5 plastic, with some composed of high-density #2 plastic. Plastic bottles and jugs are typically made of #1 or #2 plastic.

Ever wonder how plastic bottles are recycled? The first step is to separate the bottles from the caps, and into their individual resins. Plastics are then soaked in water, where the bottles made of #1 plastic will sink, and the caps (#2 or #5 plastic) will float. Recyclers then shred the #2 or #5 plastic into flakes, which are washed, rinsed and dried. Flakes then get melted into pellets and transported to manufacturers to make new products.
