

NOTICE FOR BIDS

CITY OF WINTER GARDEN, FLORIDA NINTH STREET WASTEWATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT NUMBER 09-045

The City of Winter Garden, Florida is accepting sealed bids at the Winter Garden City Hall, 300 West Plant Street, Winter Garden, Florida, 34787, until 2:30 p.m. (local time) on Tuesday, May 4th, 2010 at which time they will be opened and publicly read aloud.

Work shall include, but may not be limited to, the following: The removal of existing improvements; construction of 30" gravity wastewater main, fiberglass sanitary manholes, maintaining existing sanitary flow, pavement restoration, miscellaneous restoration and abandonment of existing 30" gravity wastewater main. Also included is providing maintenance of traffic and temporary erosion and sediment control for all areas as detailed on the plans and required by governing authorities.

Bids will be based on a UNIT PRICE method with unit prices as determined by the Contactor and provided as a part of the bid. MBE/DBE/WBE participation is encouraged.

EACH BIDDER SHALL BE REQUIRED TO PURCHASE A BID PACKAGE from the office of the ENGINEER prior to submitting his/her/its bid and have a representative attend a **MANDATORY PRE-BID MEETING**. The Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting is scheduled for 2:30 p.m. on Tuesday, April 20th, 2010 at the Winter Garden City Hall, 300 West Plant Street, Winter Garden, Florida, 34787. Bidders who have not purchased bid packages from the office of the ENGINEER prior to submitting their bids and do not have a representative attend the Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting shall be disqualified.

The City of Winter Garden reserves the right to accept or reject, in part or total, any or all bids and to waive any informalities as deemed in the best interest of the City. All bids must be marked on the outside of the envelope with the bid name, the time and date of opening. It shall be the BIDDER'S responsibility to ensure that proposals are delivered to the address above by the appointed time.
