Utility Bill Assistance for Winter Garden Low Income Seniors

Apply or re-apply for a \$35 savings each month beginning in May 2011. Applications are available at City Hall at the Receptionist Desk.

You must be 65 years of age, or 62 years of age and receiving Social Security. Income not to exceed **\$1,156.17 (Single)** or **\$1,616.37 (Married)** a month. You must have been a City resident continuously for 5 years prior to submitting your application. YOU MUST PROVIDE a copy of your 2010 Federal Income Tax Return OR your 2011 Social Security Benefit Statement and ALL other sources of income.

The deadline for submitting your application and providing the proof of your income is May 2, 2011.
