The American Cancer Society Relay For Life represents the hope that those lost to cancer will never be forgotten, that those who face cancer will be supported, and that one day cancer will be eliminated. It is an overnight event for participants to walk around a set route, starting on Friday evening and walking overnight until Saturday morning. This year's route is around the block of Tremaine Street, Lakeview Avenue, West Plant Street and Highland Avenue.

During the Relay, teams fundraise and have fun with entertainment for everyone starting at 6 pm. Several singers, choirs, bands and dance troupes will perform on the stage and at the Kidz Zone, kids can get their face painted and play carnival games. Luke Menard, the American Idol season 7 contestant and cancer survivor, is a special musical guest as well as Adam's Road and Men with Mortgages.

Proceeds from Relay help support the American Cancer Society's many programs such as Look Good-Feel Better, Road to Recovery, Reach to Recovery, Hope Lodge and ROCK children's camps. In addition to these programs the American Cancer Society has funded award winning researchers to help find a cure for cancer.
