Stormwater Pollution.... What is an Illicit Discharge?

An illicit discharge is defined in the federal regulations as: "...Any discharge to a Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4) that is not composed entirely of stormwater..."

Common Pollutants....

- Gas and motor oil
- Kitchen grease/oil
- Household cleansers
- Paints
- Pesticides
- Solvents or vehicle related spills
- Weed killers
- Grass clippings/yard waste
- Pet waste

When these pollutants find their way into the storm sewer system, even unintentionally, they cause serious health and water quality problems, such as destruction of the natural habitat. To help protect the quality of our wetlands, rivers, lakes and public health, please report sources of pollution you witness along the roadside or in your neighborhood.
