

Downtown Winter Garden Cruz N Car Show Rules of the Road

Thank you for choosing Downtown Winter Garden as your quarterly cruise-in destination!

The quarterly dates for the car show are the third Saturdays in **January, April, June and September from 4 pm to 8 pm.**

Parking

- Cars can arrive at 2:00 pm and stage at the Plant and Dillard parking lot as directed by staff. Once parked, you will not be able to move your car until 3:30 pm.
- **There are no reserved or saving of parking spaces.** It is first come, first serve. To park with your friends, arrive together.
- Cars are allowed to park on Plant Street between 3:30 pm and 4:00 pm.
 - At 3:40 pm, staff and volunteers will direct cars onto Plant Street in the order they arrived
 - Early parking on Plant Street is NOT allowed.
 - ONLY volunteers with approval are granted early parking.
 - Plant Street turns into a **pedestrian walkway** as soon as the event officially begins and cars will not be able to move without an event escort.
 - **If you have an emergency and need to leave before event ends** at 8:00 pm, call for an escort by calling the nonemergency police number at 407-656-3636.

Arriving after 4:00

- **Cars arriving after the event starts at 4 pm** shall enter the event at Lakeview Avenue and Tremaine Street and will be able to park in the spaces around the Downtown Pavilion, along Tremaine Street or across from City Hall.
- Once the available parking spaces along Plant Street and side streets are full, the event is closed and no additional cruisers will be allowed in the event area.
- **If you plan to leave early** (before 8:00 pm), park in the Downtown Pavilion Area or across from City Hall.

Drawings and Awards

- Held at the **WJB Sound Trailer at 7:30 pm** – you MUST BE PRESENT at the fountain to win and have your car number In-hand. We move quickly, **PLEASE be ready at 7:30 pm.**

Additional Information

- Sidewalk space is limited in some areas. In these areas, sit on the trail side of the streets in **grass areas**, to allow people with disabilities to navigate and keep store entrances open for customers.
- Be mindful not to block the sidewalk or the trail.
- No alcohol is allowed to be consumed on public right of way per City Code.
- We know you have awesome cars, but showing off (revving engines, spinning tires, driving fast) is **not permitted** in the downtown areas and adjoining streets, before, during or after the event).

This event is sponsored by the City of Winter Garden along with volunteers. The staff and volunteers are here to support the event and make sure it is safe and enjoyable – please follow their direction.

In the effort to bring the attendance into a more manageable number, the following criteria will be put in place effective with the April 20th, 2019, Car Show. (January's car count was attended by almost 400 cars). There will also be adjustments to parking, to better feature classics along Plant Street.

- Plant Street parking will be set aside for 1987 or older, **show-quality** vehicles FIRST
- Cruisers will be directed to park in two different queue lines based on the categories described above and as directed by staff
- Newer, **show-quality** muscle cars can fill-in open spots on Plant Street **after the classic cars** have parked or fill spaces by the Pavilion and alongside streets
- Cars that do not meet the criteria on April 20th will not be able to participate
