



Orange County Senior Climate Efficiency Program

The Orange County Senior Climate Efficiency Program (SCEP) serves to provide low-income seniors (60+) in Orange County with air conditioner replacement, service, or system upgrades. As well as completing health and safety improvements in clients' homes, the program will also preserve the senior housing stock in Orange County.

Services

- Automatically replace air conditioner if:
 - Unit is more than 10 years old
 - Mismatch units (indoor & outdoor units are different makes or ages)
- Repair, service & clean if necessary/possible
 - Contractor must provide certificate of service
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- Install smart thermostat with auto-function capability
- Provide A/C filters (Install 1, leave 2 with client)
- Repair/seal ductwork, return, and/or supplies

Administration

- Age qualification: 60 or older
- Income qualification: Already qualified for WAP; or qualified for FSSP, LIHEAP, Food Stamps, or Section 8 Housing
- Simplified client intake form that establishes home ownership, income level, and age of occupant(s)
- Provide client education on efficient A/C & thermostat operation
